Fit in Deutsch 1 and Goethe-Certificate A2, Fit in Deutsch – An enrichment for the portfolio



What do the Goethe-Certificates offer your students?

Fit in Deutsch 1 and 2 are two internationally recognised certificates for secondary school students to prove that they reached level A1 or A2 of the Common European Framework for languages. The examinations are a good way to motivate students in the Transition Year to continue with their German studies.

The Goethe-Certificates also offer you the opportunity to measure the level of language of your students. For the first time the students can also do an oral exam in German, and might feel more confident for the LC.



Information about the examination

The Goethe-Institut has been offering the *Fit in Deutsch* exams in Ireland for over a decade now and the feedback from teachers and students has been very positive. Every year up to 200 students and more have been sitting the exams

The Goethe-Certificates have the same structure worldwide and consist of the following parts:

- Listening
- Reading
- Writing
- Speaking

The focus of each part is on the **ability to communicate** in German. Topics covered would be relevant to teenagers, such as: school, hobbies, sports, friends etc. *Fit in Deutsch* does not only measure the knowledge of the students, but beyond that also motivates them to keep on learning.

Training for teachers

The Fit in Deutsch 2 exam was replaced by the exam **"Goethe-Zertifikat A2, Fit in Deutsch"**. This new format is much **more demanding,** and the requirements are not comparable to the JC. Therefore, we **highly recommend** participating in one of the training sessions, if you are not familiar with the A2 exam
